TWO CONTRASTING JAZZ PIANO STYLES

The New York area is blessed with dozen or so really fine jazz pianists. Since most engagements require only one of them they are rarely heard playing together. What a rare delight it is to find two of the best paired up for an evening of keyboard artistry, at our convenient New Jersey location too.

Jazz pianists **Janice Friedman** and **Mar Shane** will share our Altenburg grand for an evening of exciting piano jazz. The date of this Pianofest is Friday evening, February 10 starting at 8 PM. Tickets are only \$10, and light intermission refreshments are included in the price.

"Pianist **Janice Friedman** is in virtual constant demand in New York," notes a reviewer, "thanks to her big sound and vibrant, incisive playing." Indeed she must be, given the list of clubs, concert halls and festivals she frequents. At age 27, she toured nationwide with the Woody Herman Orchestra, and works regularly these days with various groups headed by cornetist Warren Vaché. Critic John S. Wilson called her piano work "explosive... carrying the aura and variety of a big band, with only bass and drums as accompaniment."
